


Saddle Stop Fitting Instructions



- Choose relevant fixing bracket and install. (See separate instructions).
- Attach rear hoop assembly to fixing bracket using M8 button head fasteners and tighten into threaded block inside rectangular hollow section or threaded holes in the case of Standard Wall Bracket, with allen key provided.

TIP:-

To make insertion of fasteners easier use a small amount of Blu-Tack or equivalent on button head to hold it onto allen key whilst starting thread.

3. Tap in black plastic inserts into end of hollow section where necessary.

- 4. With front hook removed, place saddle into rear hoop assembly, and then fit front hook. The keys are not required to lock the plunge lock, simply push lock into best fitting hole until lock 'clicks'.
- 5. To remove Saddle Stop, insert key, rotate 1/2 turn, pull on key until lock pops out.
