SHERWOOD CLASSIC & ORIGINAL BATH PANELS

FITTING INSTRUCTIONS

Baths are usually set up to 525mm high. The complete panel comprises a main panel 450mm deep and a plinth 125mm deep providing a maximum overall panel height of 550mm.

The front panel should then be placed in position, ensuring the lipped edge is located between the roll of the bath and the bath frames.

The panel can then be secured to the plinth using screws, ensuring the overall height of the panel and plinth is correct. We would recommend 3 screws, 1 in the centre and 1 at near to each end. (Screws not provided)

The plinth should be secured to a batten at floor level, ensuring alignment with the bath.

If an end panel is required, the same procedure should be followed, with the end panel fitting behind the front panel.

If either the front or end panel need to be cut during installation, please ensure all cut edges are re-sealed.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

If at any point the panel or plinth have to be cut to suit a particular bath length or height, or to aid installation, then any cut surface must be re-sealed prior to installation.

Failure to comply with this instruction may result in the MDF core absorbing water and the surface lifting and blistering.
