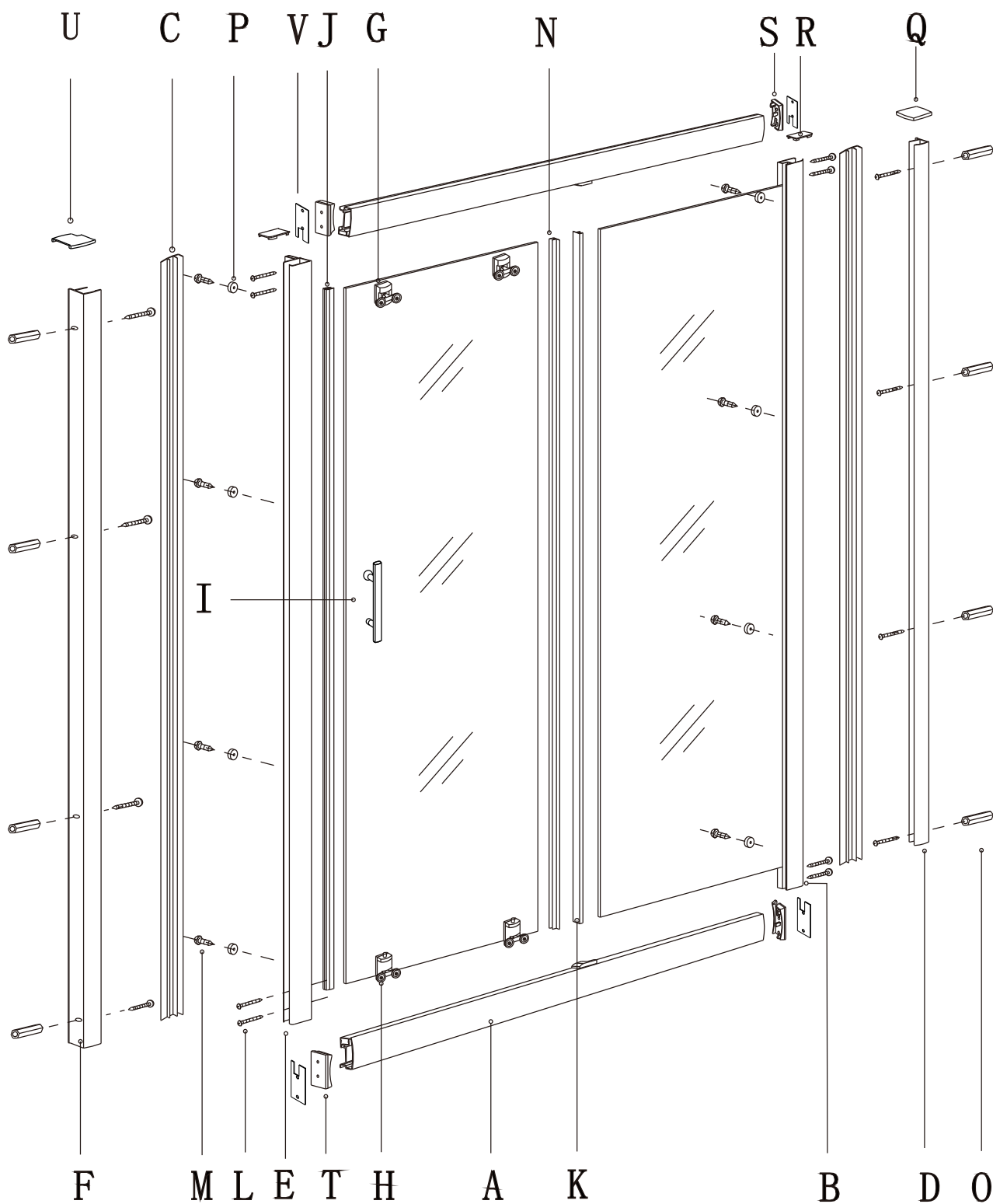


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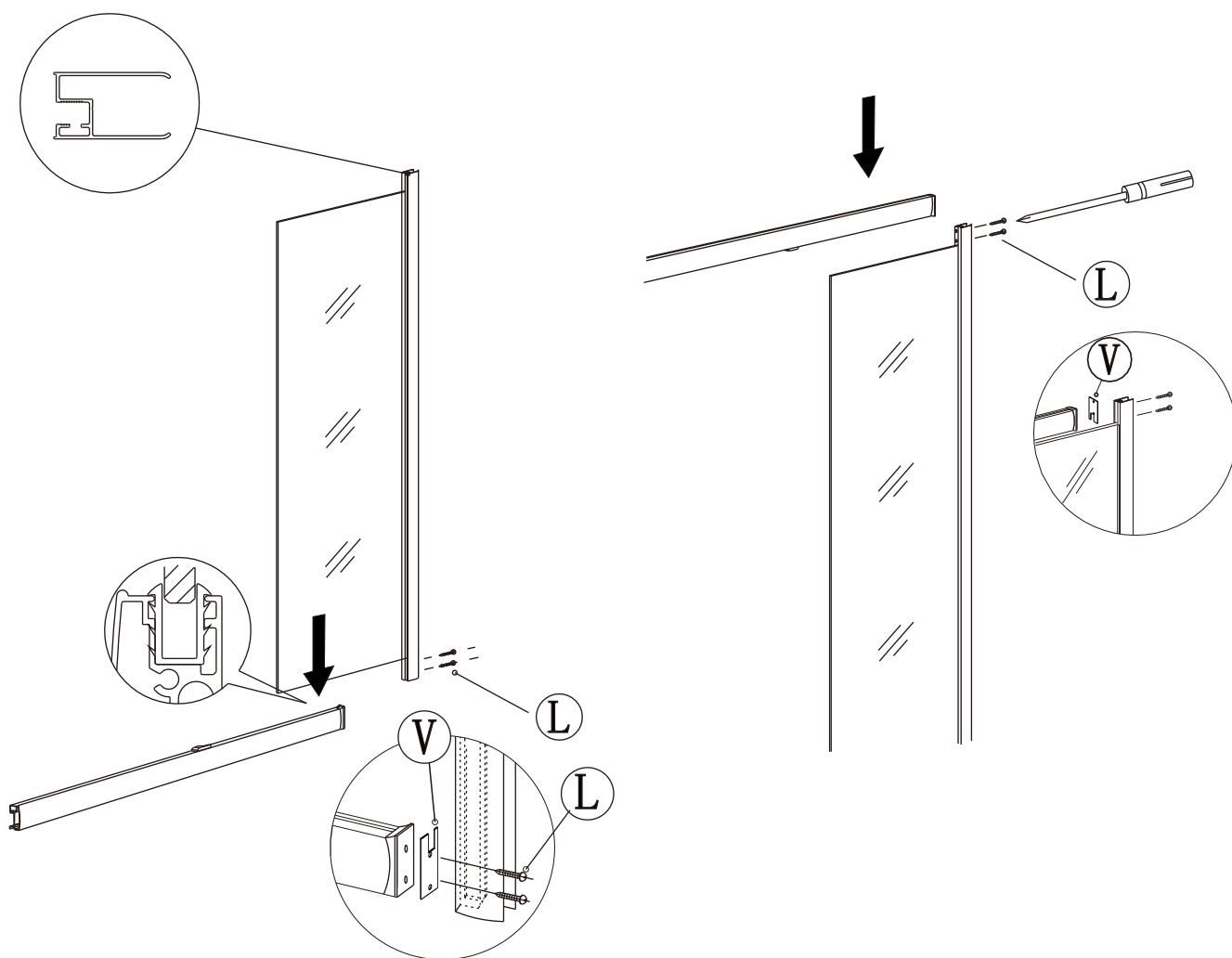
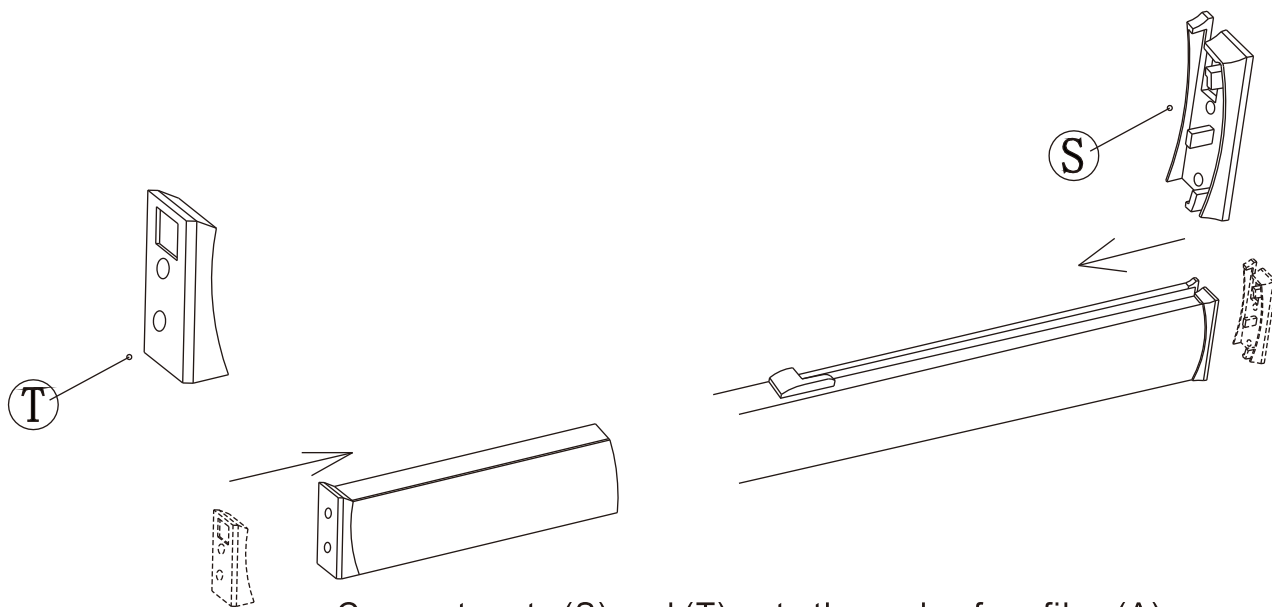
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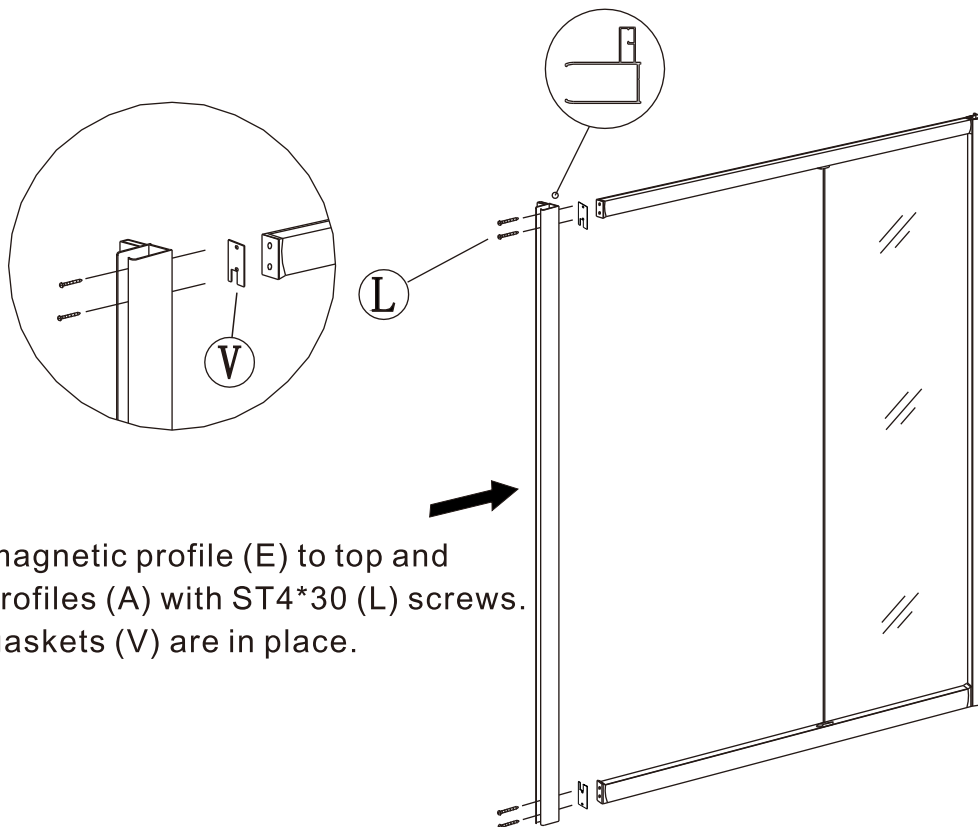
PRODUCT SCHEMATIC DIAGRAM



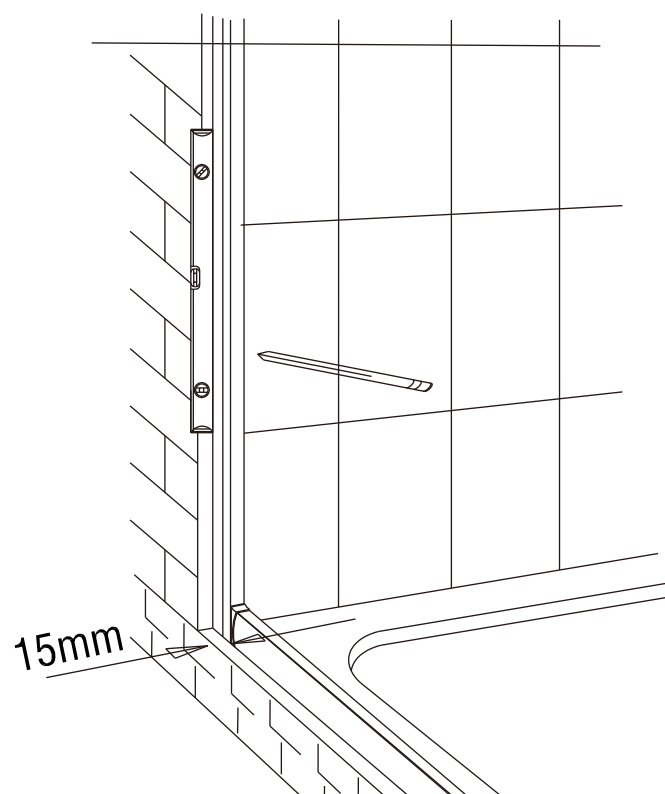
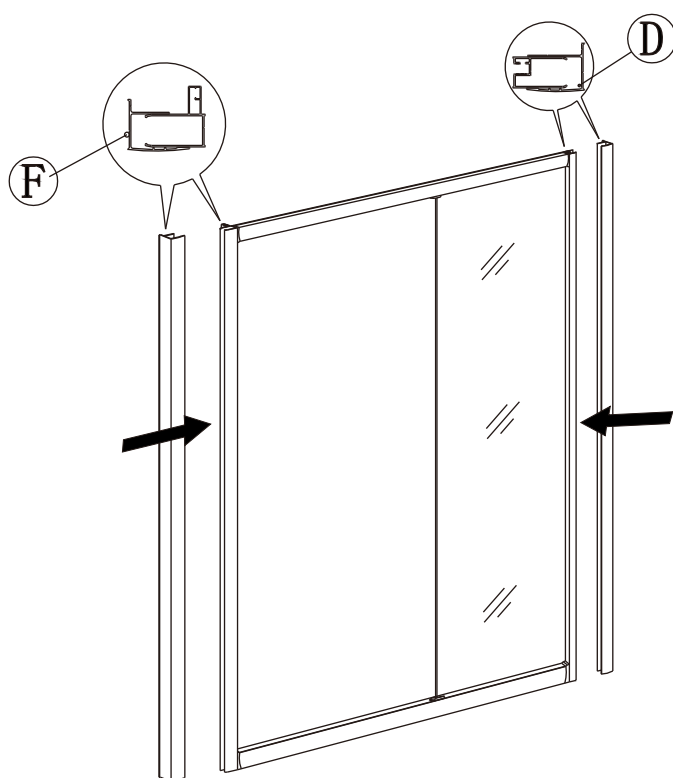
Please make the following checks before commencing installation:

- Make sure you have all the tools required.



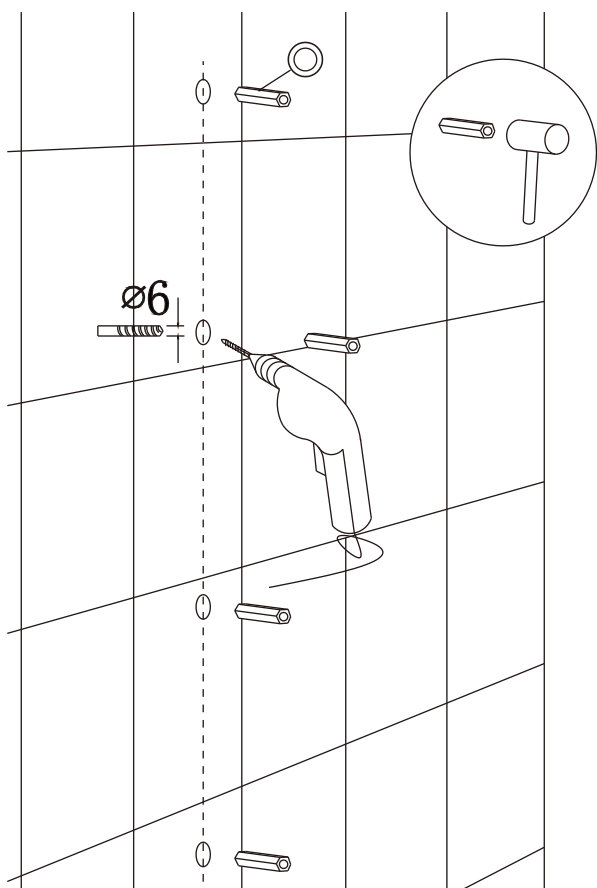


Secure magnetic profile (E) to top and bottom profiles (A) with ST4*30 (L) screws. Ensure gaskets (V) are in place.



Place wall profiles (F) and (D) onto ends of slider frame as shown. Lift into position level and mark wall profile fixing holes.

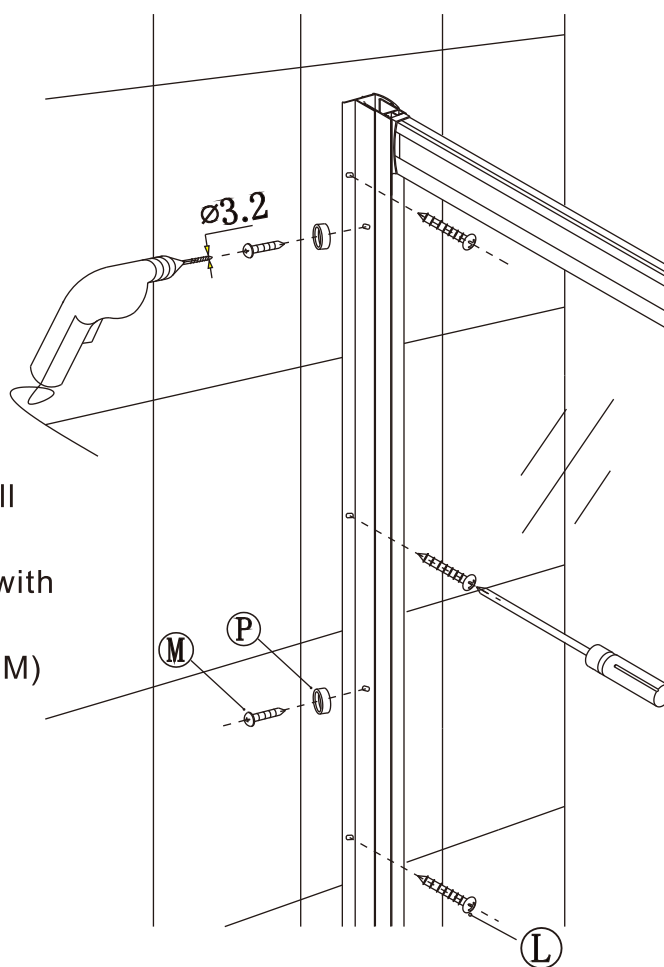


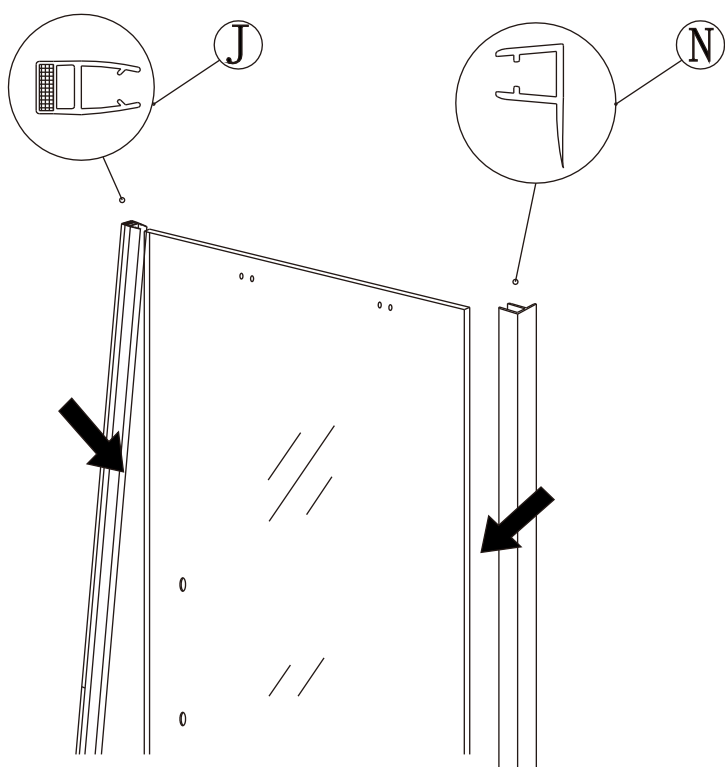
Drill fixing holes in wall with 6mm bit.
Fit wall plugs (O).
Please substitute for suitable hollow
wall fixings if installing onto a stud wall.

Lift slider into position and secure onto wall
with ST4*30 (L) screws.

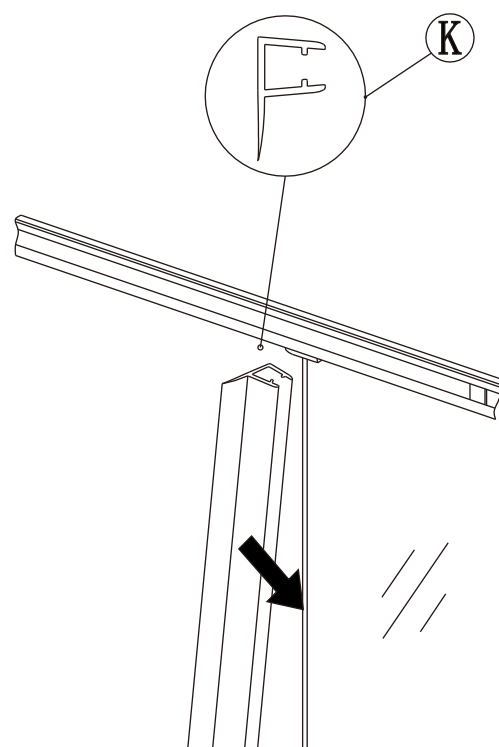
Position slider as required and drill frame with
3.2mm bit.

Secure slider to wall profiles with ST4*12 (M)
screws and washers (P).

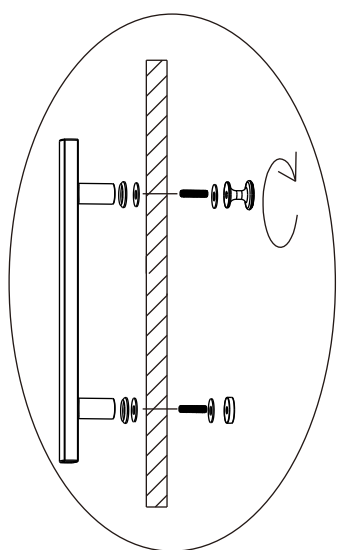




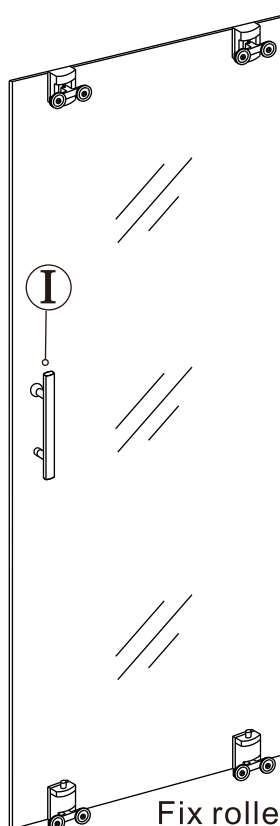
Fix magnetic seal (J) and anti-water strip (N) onto door.



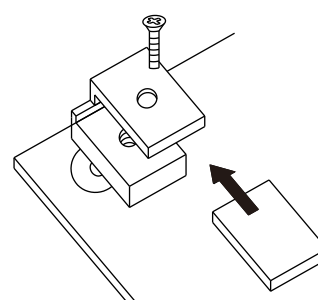
Fixed anti-water strip (K) onto fixed glass panel.



Secure handle (I) to door.

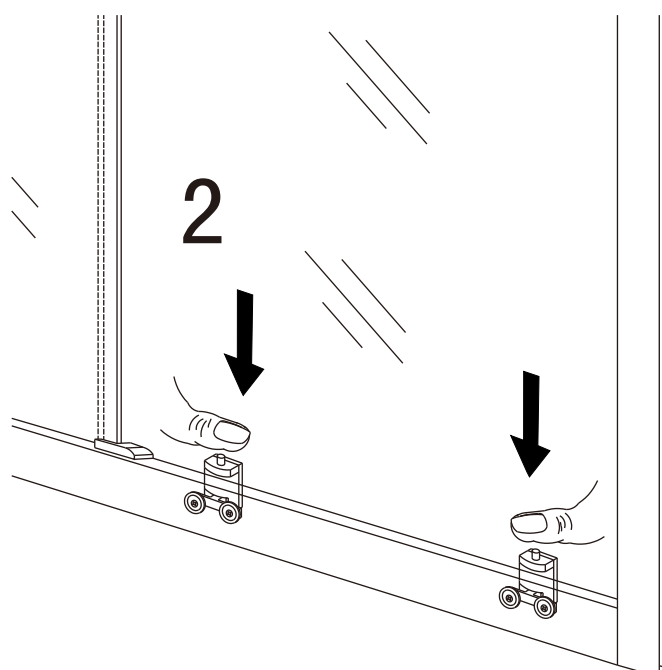
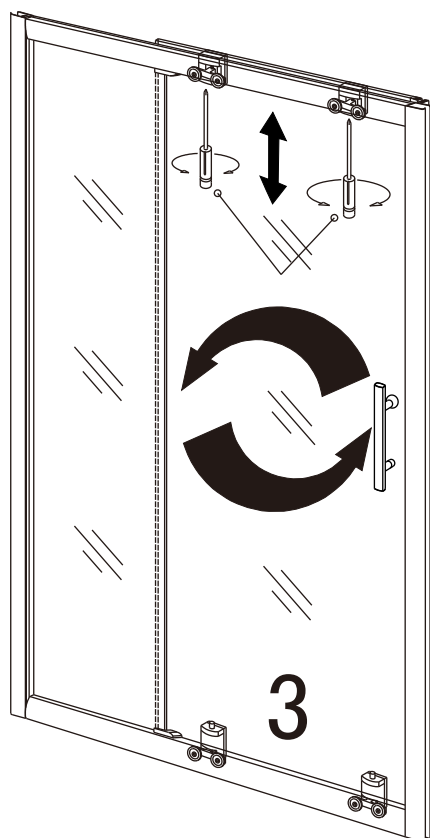
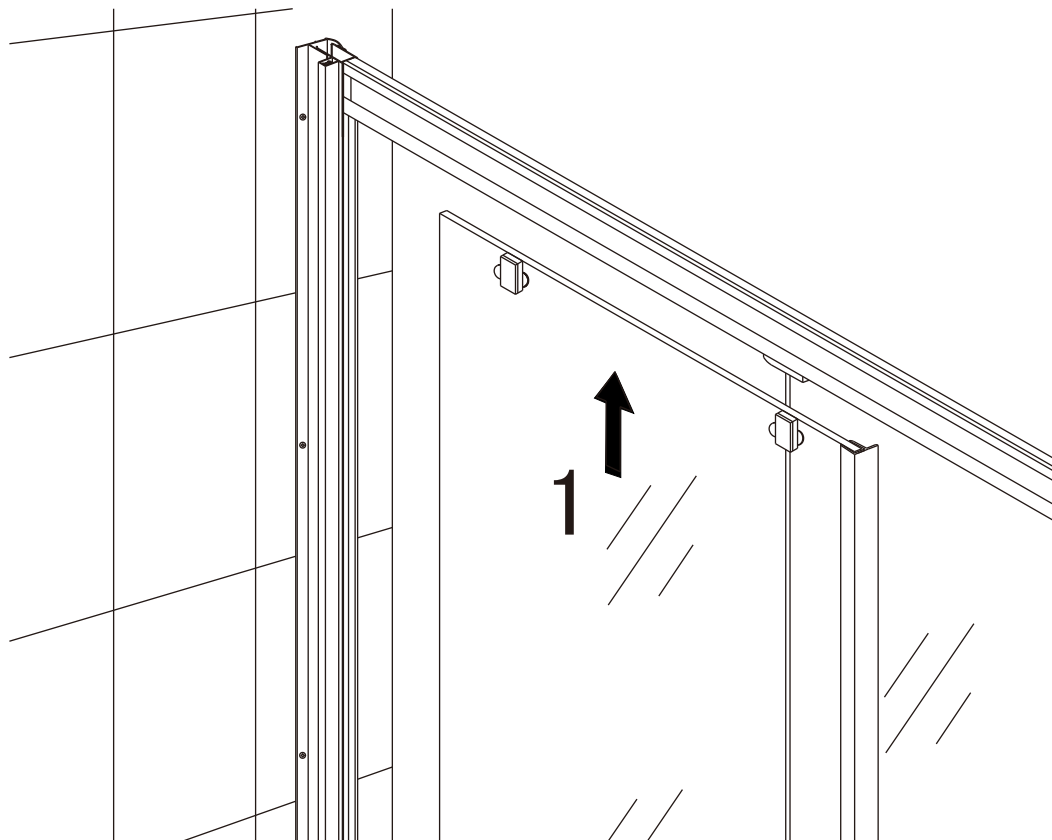

Fix rollers (G) to top of door and bottom rollers (H) to bottom of door.

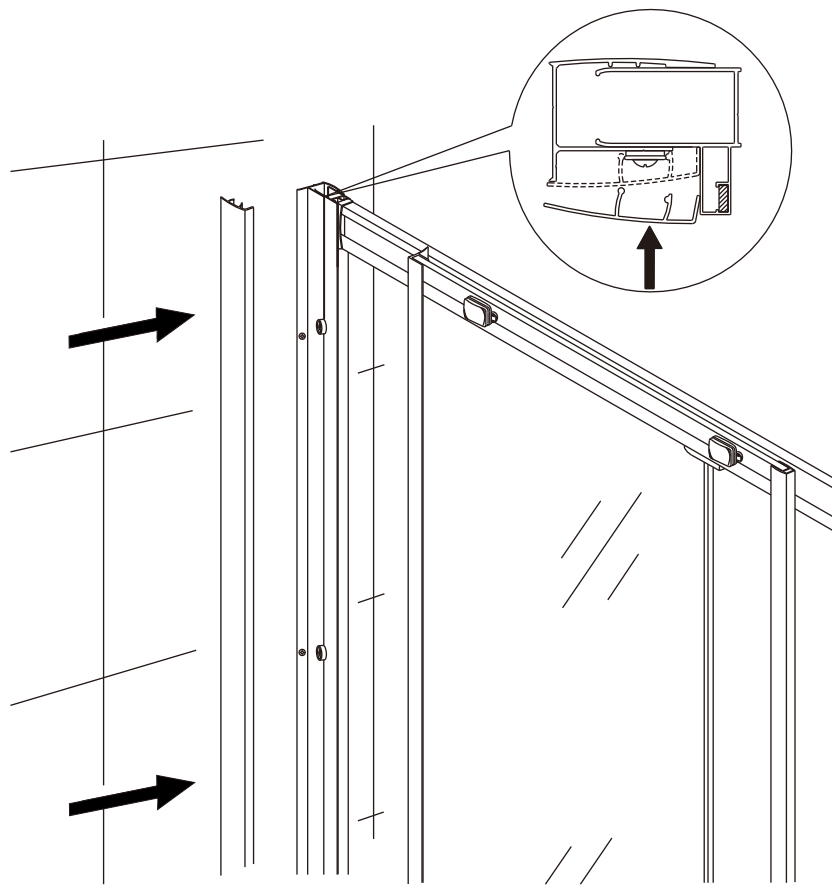


Lift top rollers onto top rail.

Push down on bottom rollers and click into bottom rail of frame.

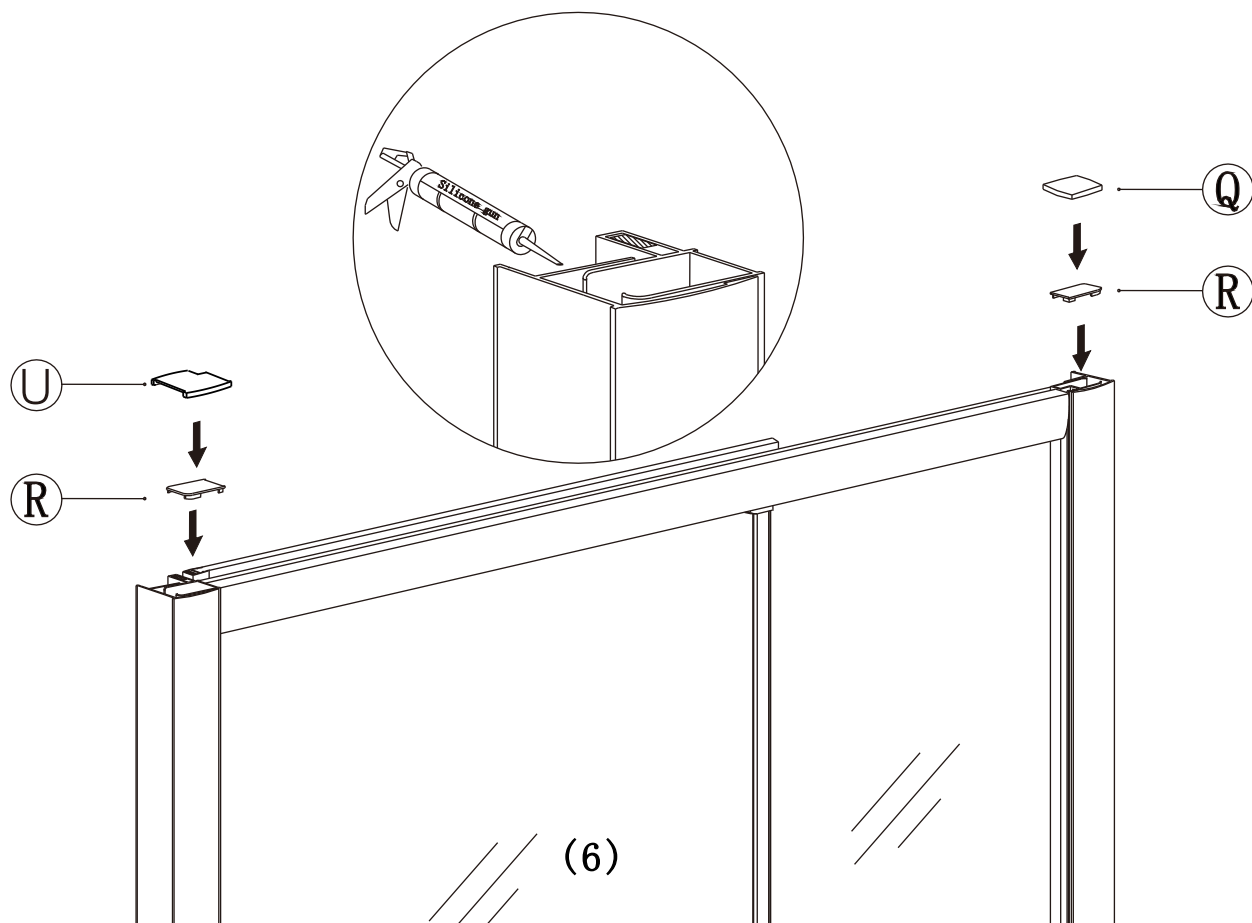
Adjust rollers as required.

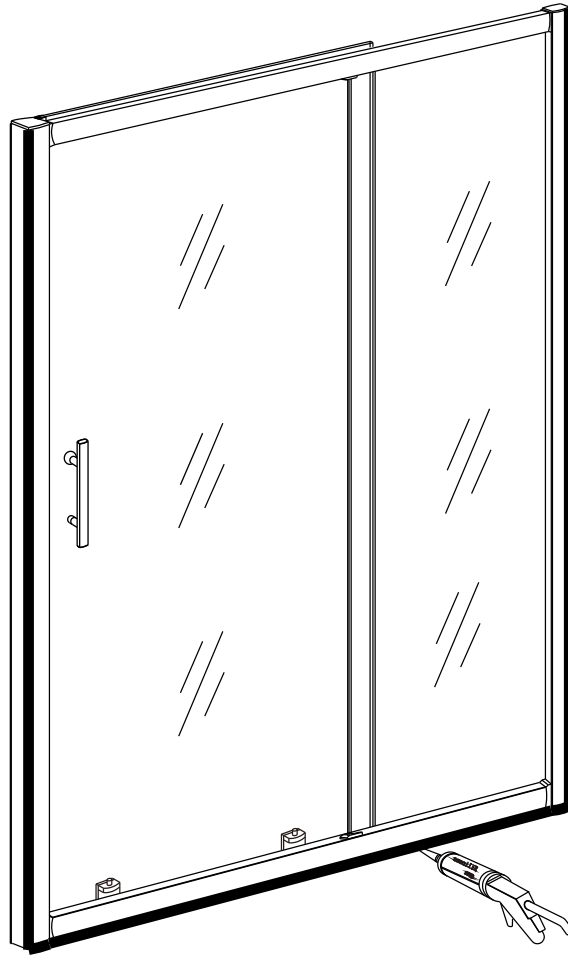

Cleaning and Maintenance of Shower Enclosures

Do not clean the shower enclosure with irritant detergents such as alcohol, bleach or other chemical cleaners.

Only clean with mild soapy water or a proprietary cleaner where the label advises it is suitable for the materials the enclosure is constructed from, test on a small area first.

For treating limescale we would recommend distilled vinegar in a half and half solution with water.

Following installation should you find that there is a notable noise when the glass door moves you may add a small amount of silicone lubricant onto the roller wheels and tracks, hinges or clips.

It is the responsibility of the product owner to maintain the product as recommended above. Also to check for parts which have broken or become loose to protect against failure of the enclosure.
