- Make sure you have all the tools required.

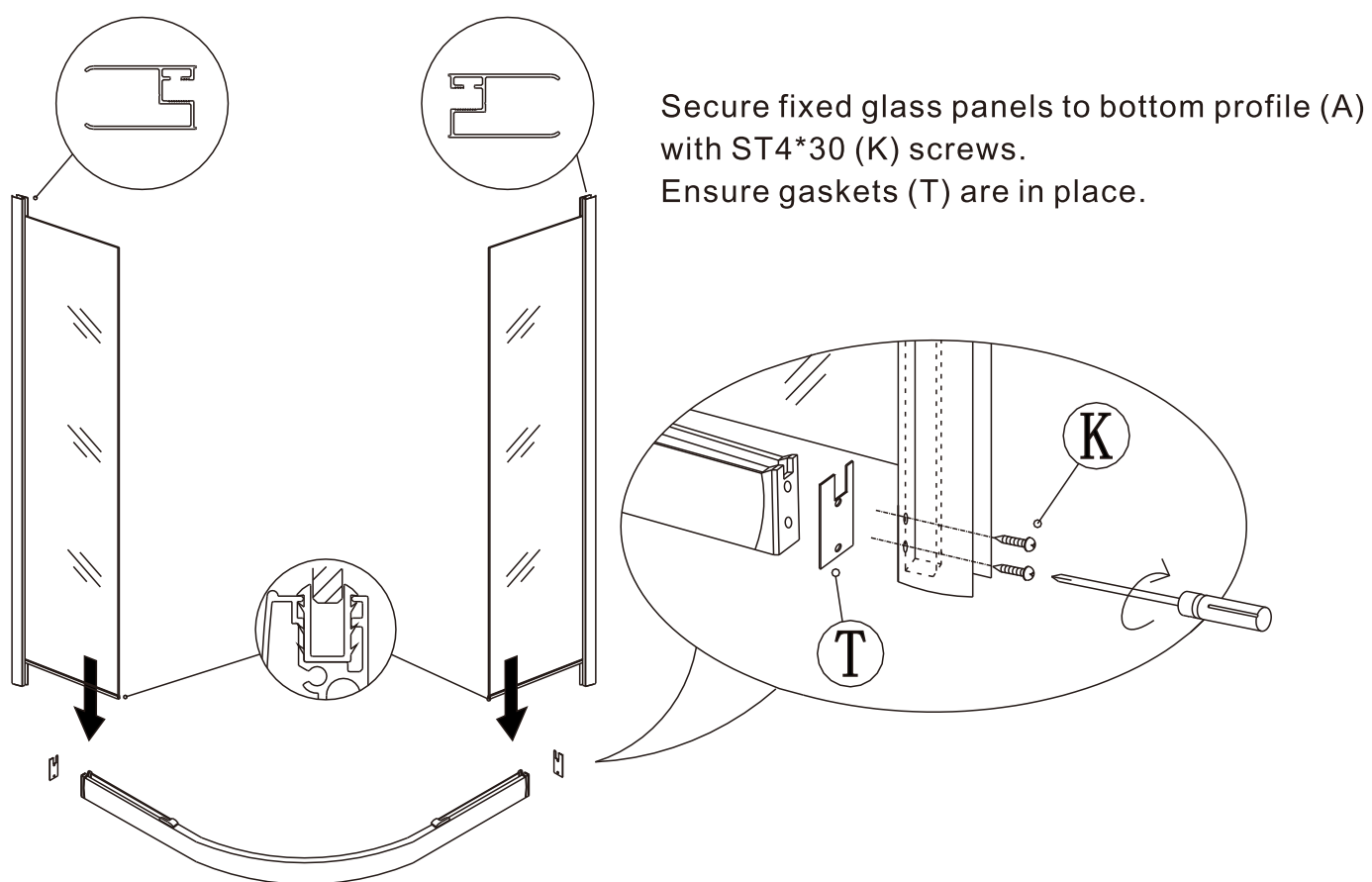
PRODUCT SCHEMATIC DIAGRAM



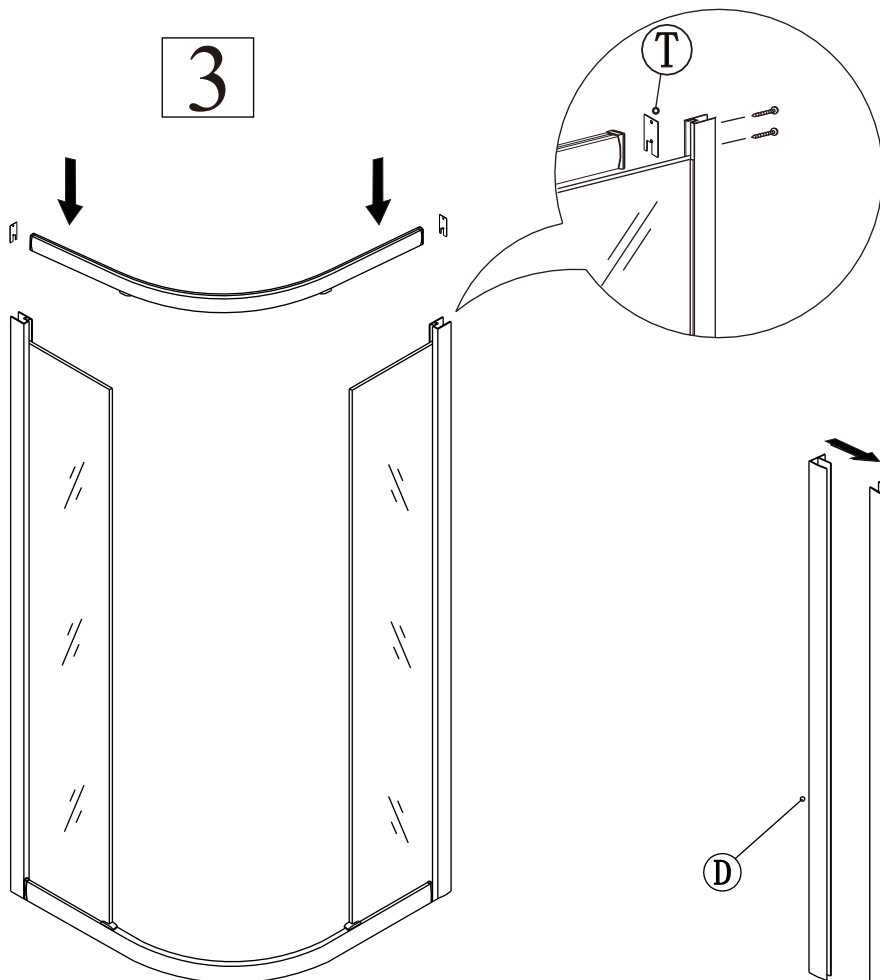

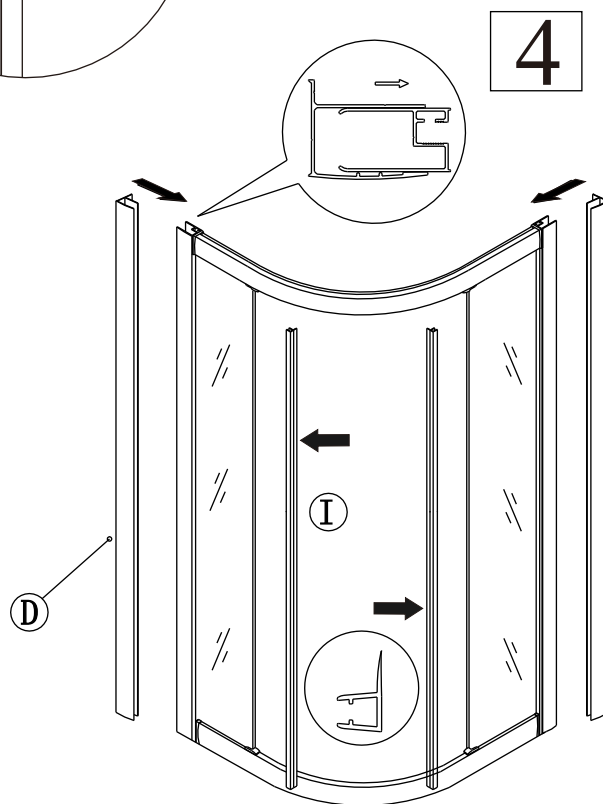
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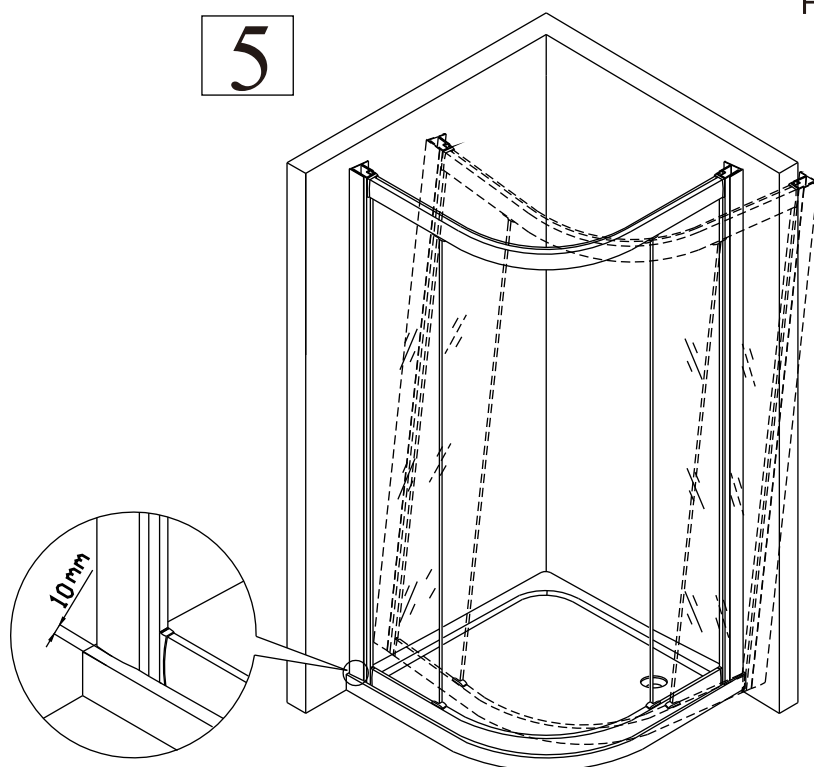

Ensure gaskets (T) are in place.

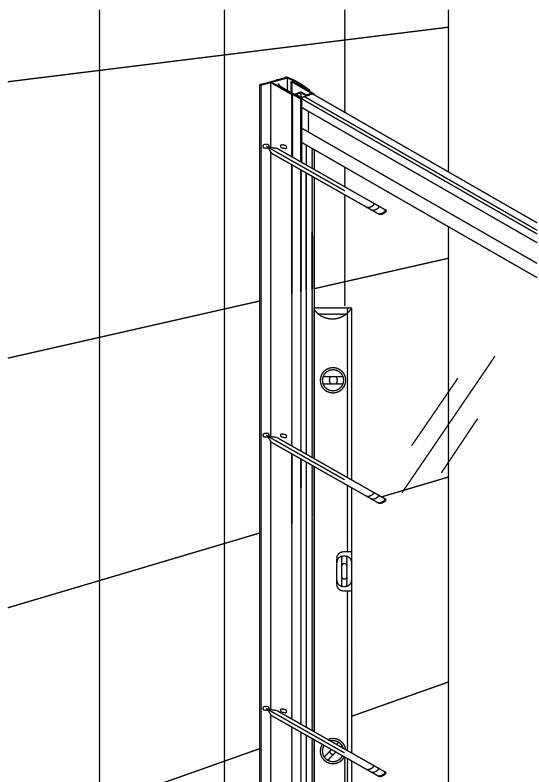


Place wall profiles (D) onto end of quad frame.
Fix anti-water strips (I).



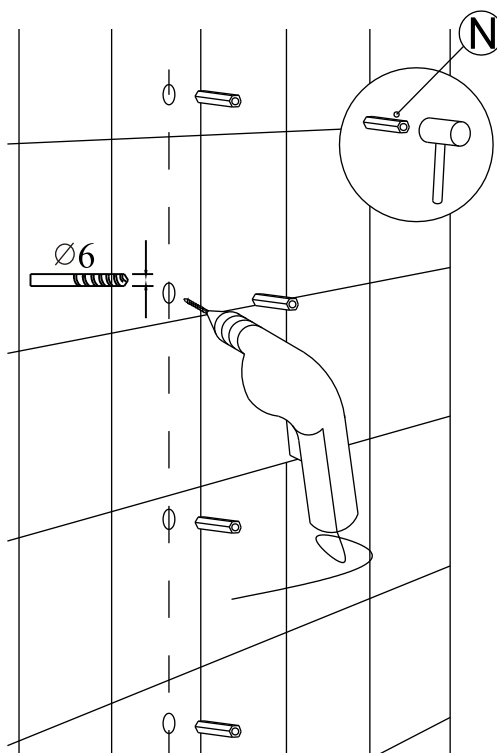
Lift quad with wall profiles in place

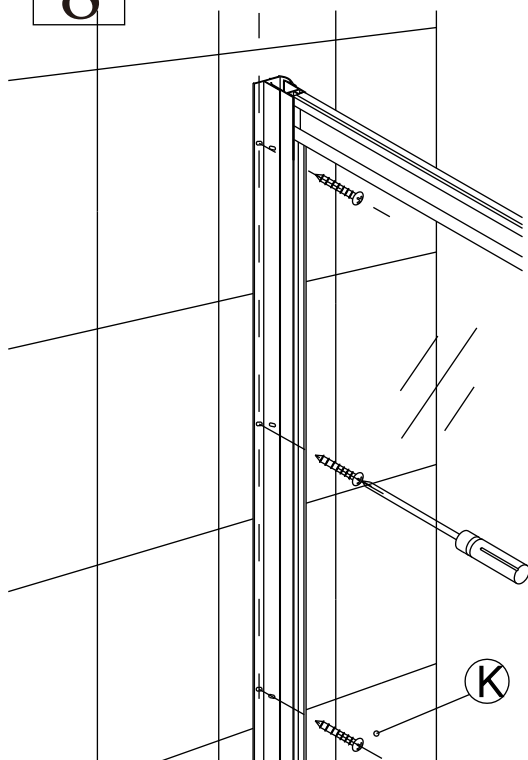
Level and mark wall profile fixing holes.

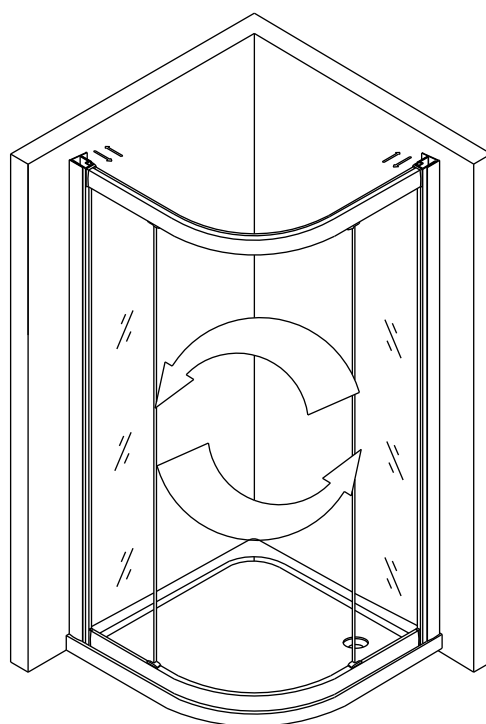
Drill fixing holes with 6mm bit. Fit wall plugs (N). Substitute for hollow wall fixings if installing onto a stud wall.

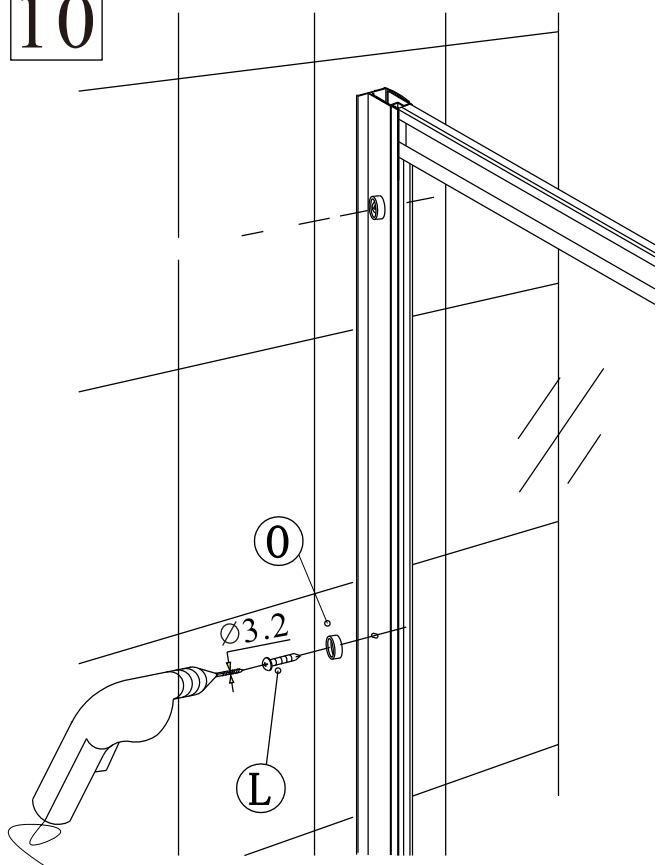
Fix in position with ST4*30 (K) screws.

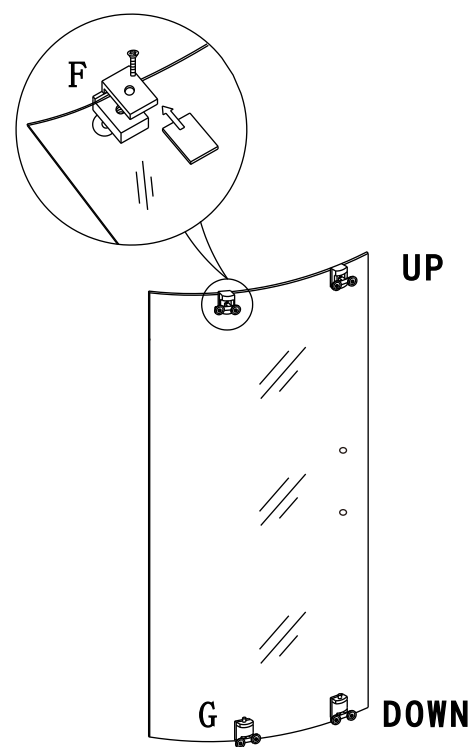
Adjust in profiles as required.

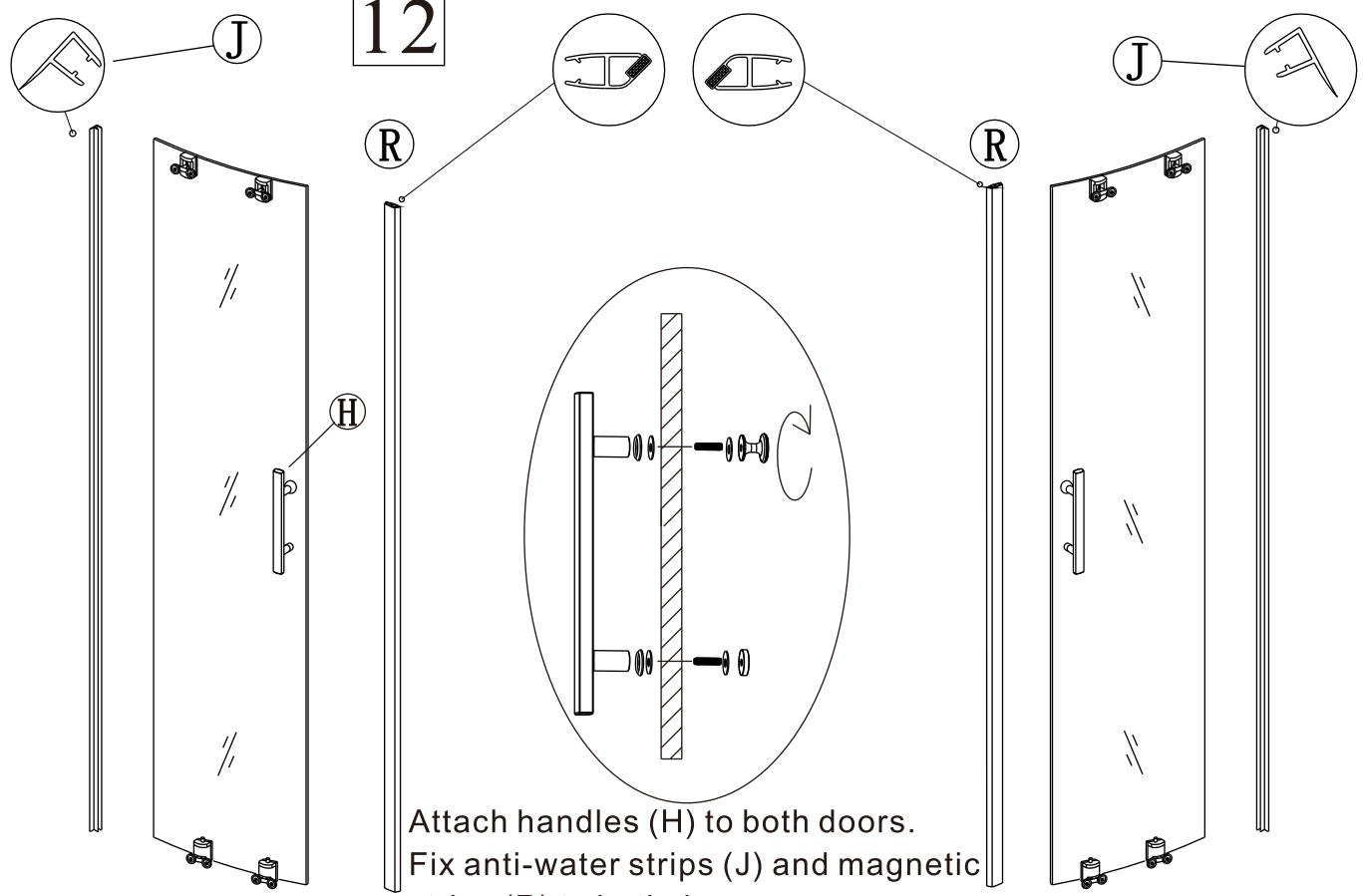
Drill quad frame with 3.2mm bit.

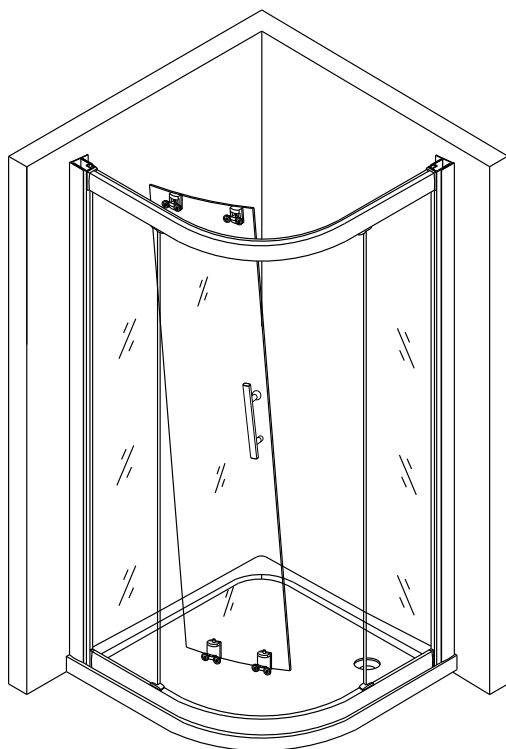
Fix rollers (F) to top of door and rollers (G) to bottom.

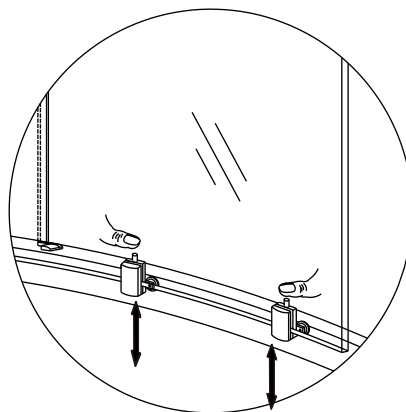


Attach handles (H) to both doors.

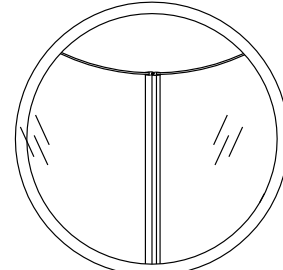
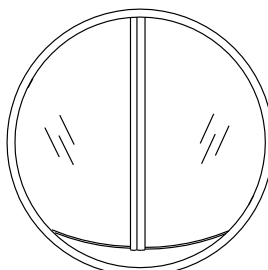
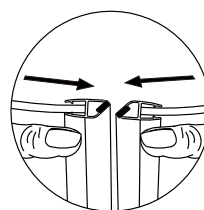
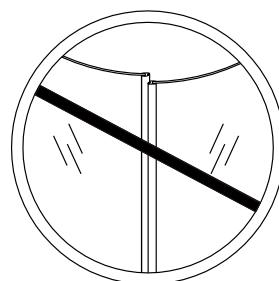
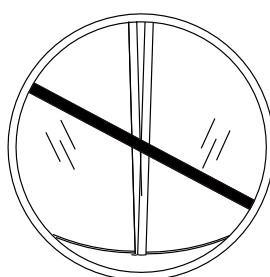
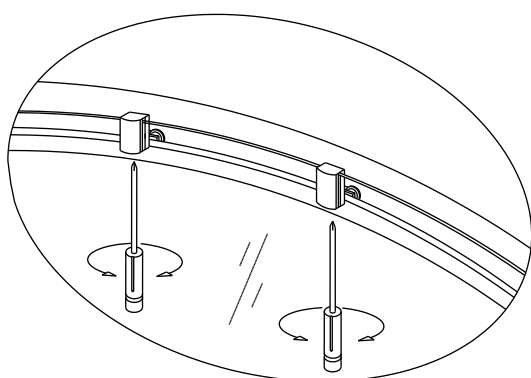


Lift top rollers onto top rail of quad.
Push down on bottom roller and click into bottom rail.

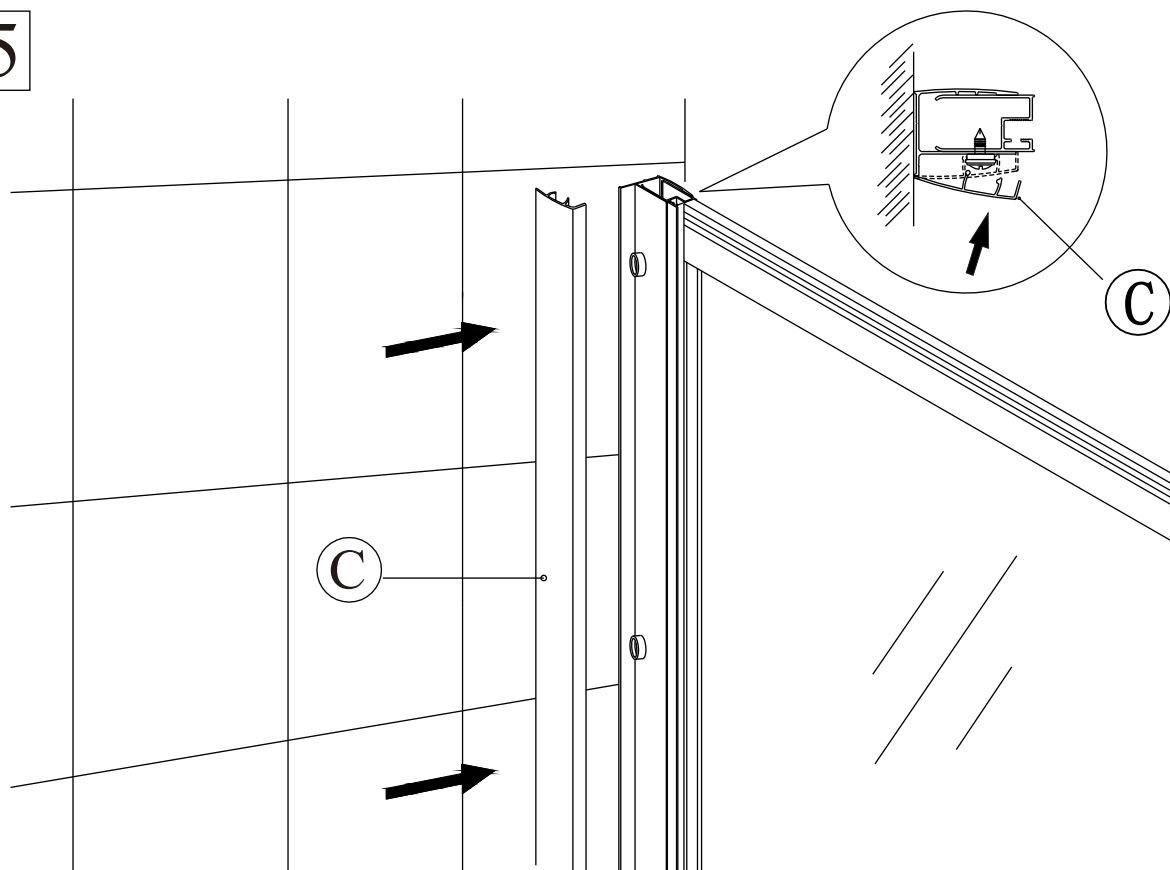

Adjust rollers as required to ensure doors connect correctly.

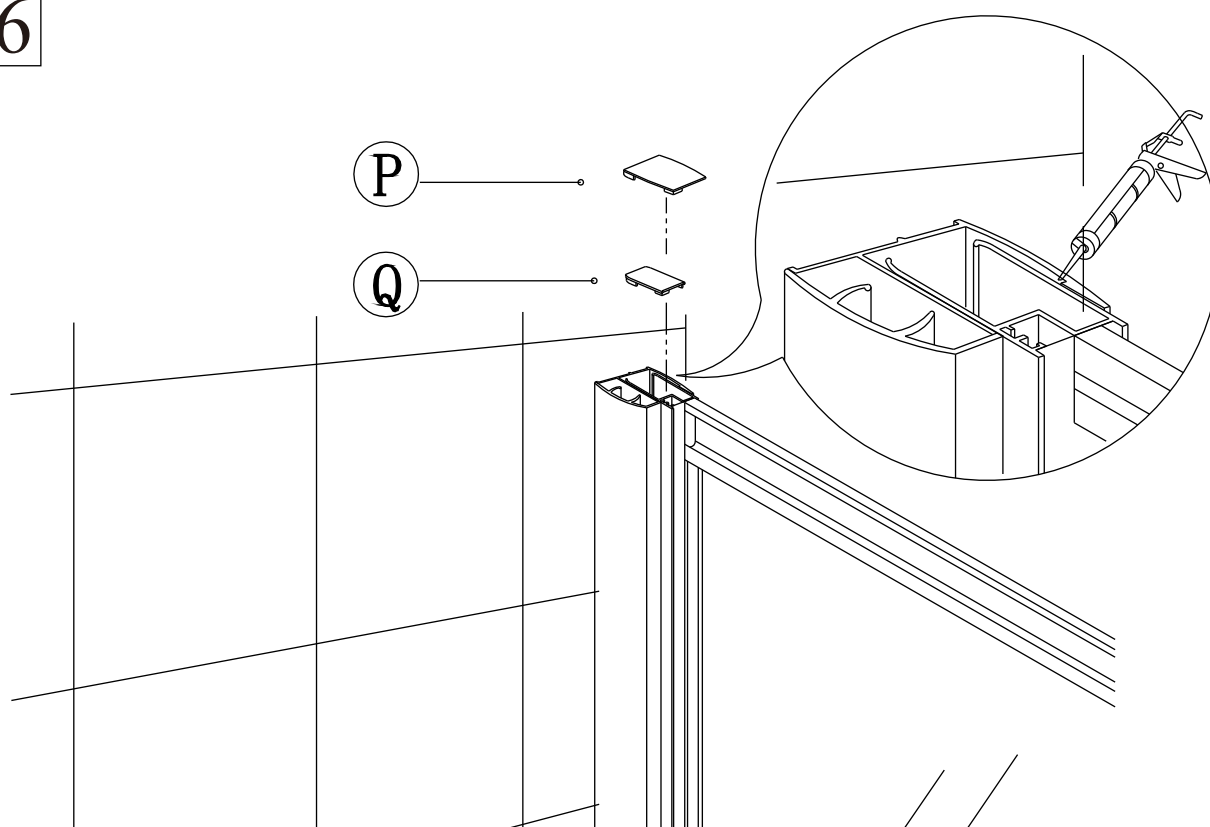

Clip screw cover profiles (C) onto washer (O).

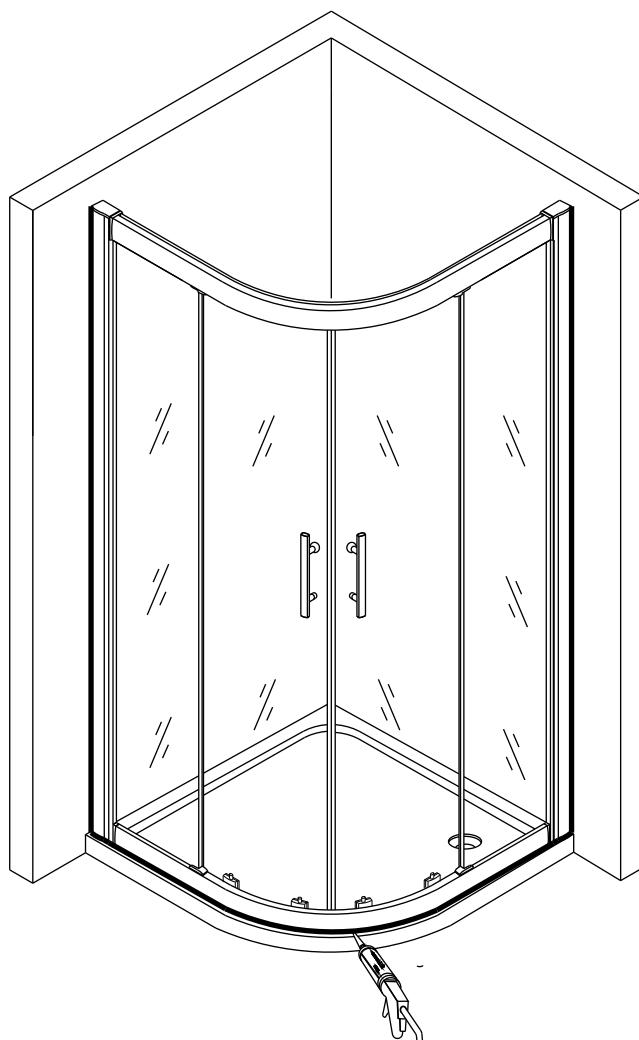

Cleaning and Maintenance of Shower Enclosures

Do not clean the shower enclosure with irritant detergents such as alcohol, bleach or other chemical cleaners.

Only clean with mild soapy water or a proprietary cleaner where the label advises it is suitable for the materials the enclosure is constructed from, test on a small area first.

For treating limescale we would recommend distilled vinegar in a half and half solution with water.

Following installation should you find that there is a notable noise when the glass door moves you may add a small amount of silicone lubricant onto the roller wheels and tracks, hinges or clips.

It is the responsibility of the product owner to maintain the product as recommended above. Also to check for parts which have broken or become loose to protect against failure of the enclosure.
