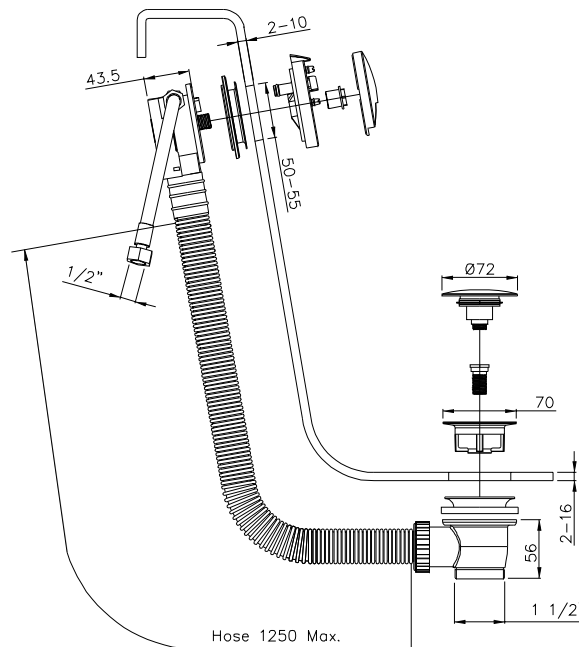

In the unlikely event that you should experience any defect in the materials or workmanship of your new Abode product within FIVE years of purchase, the purchaser's sole remedy shall be the replacement (at the manufacturer's discretion) of all or any part of the product that is defective. All working parts and valves are guaranteed for a period of FIVE years from purchase. Decorative surface finishes and O-rings are guaranteed for ONE year from the date of purchase provided that our advice concerning care has been observed and no scouring agents have been used.

This is provided that the product has been used for normal domestic purposes in the UK and that the care, installation and maintenance instructions have been observed. The warranty extends to the original purchaser only. You should retain a copy of your dated invoice as proof of purchase to validate any claims under this guarantee.

Marks, scuffs and scratches caused by improper installation or accidental damage are not covered by this guarantee. Neither are shade variations or any

damage or defect caused by incorrect installation or abuse of the fitting.

Care Instructions for your Overflow filler and Waste

To maintain the appearance of this product, ensure that it is regularly cleaned only using a clean, soft damp cloth. A solution of warm water and a mild liquid detergent may be used where necessary, and then the fitting rinsed thoroughly and wiped dry. Any other cleaning action or cleaning products will invalidate your warranty.

Abrasive cleaners, scouring cleaners, limescale cleaners and acidic cleaners must not be used under any circumstances. Avoid contact with all solvents (including chlorinated solvents, ketones or acetones as these may result in surface deterioration or etching). Also avoid contact with any harsh household chemicals such as bleach cleaners, drain cleaners, rust removers, paint strippers and toilet bowl cleaners, toothpaste, mouthwash, bar keepers friend or Brasso.

Installation Instructions:

Preparation

All parts should be removed from their packaging and inspected for any transport damage and completeness prior to installation; you should read these instructions throughout before commencing installation. We do not accept responsibility for problems that may occur through improper installation. Always ensure you have sufficient hot and cold water pressure available to allow correct function before specifying or installing this product.

Before installing the new product it is essential that you thoroughly flush through the supply pipes in order to remove any remaining solder, swarf or impurities from your system. Failure to carry out this simple procedure could cause problems or damage to the workings of the product.

All serviceable parts should be given suitable access to allow easy future maintenance.

Shut off your water heating system and ensure that your mains stopcock is closed. Ensure both the hot and cold water supplies are isolated before commencing installation.

You should ensure that the product will both fit into the depth of the mounting surface available and reach the required outlet position before installation. This product requires 50-55mm Ø hole for the overflow.

Overflow Installation

1. Place large rubber seal (D) into rear body (G), making sure they are aligned centrally with the rear of the bath cut out. Pass seal (D) through the overflow hole so the seal sits either side of the hole.
2. Whilst holding the back of the rear body (G), slot front body (C) into rear body (G) from the front of the bath cut out
3. Tighten the connection between the rear body (G) and front body (C) with fixing bolt (B) using the Key tool (R)
4. Once tightened, snap fit the decorative cover (A) to the front body (C).
5. Screw the flexi tail (H) on either side of the rear body (G) making sure the opposite entry (not required) is blocked of with rubber washer (F) and sealing nut (E).
6. Connect flexible tube (I) to the bottom of the rear body (G) by pushing on firmly.

Waste Installation

1. Pass nut (J) washer (K) then tapered seal (L) over the flexible hose (I). **Note the orientation of tapered seal (L).**
2. Connect the flexible hose (I) to the lower waste body (M) using nut (J). If required hose (I) can be cut to length. **Note: If cutting hose (I) make sure there is sufficient length to reach the lower waste body (M) from the bottom of rear body (G).**
3. Place the small rubber seal (N) onto the lower waste body (M). Pass seal (N) so it sits front and back of the waste hole
4. Place the upper waste body (O) into the bath waste hole. Ensure the flange of the upper waste body (O) and seal (N) sit centrally inside the recess of the bath waste hole.
5. Whilst holding the lower waste body (M) and lower rubber seal (N) up to the waste hole on the underside of the bath, tighten the upper waste body (O) to the lower waste body (M) with the fixing bolt (P). Ensure the overflow inlet connection on the lower waste body (G) faces towards the overflow when fixed in position.
6. Place the waste plug (Q) into the upper waste body (O).

After installation

Turn on your water heating system and ensure that your mains stopcock is open. Reconnect both the hot and cold water supplies to this fitting.

Check the function of flow and function of hot, cold and mixed water.

Turn off the product and check carefully for any leaks around all connections on the fitting and adjoining plumbing. If possible return to the installation after a longer period to double check for slower leaks. If pressure testing equipment is available check the installation to the maximum recommended pressure.

Clean the product to remove any marks created during installation as instructed, then place a bag over the product to protect the product until it is ready for use.
